

Fund Overview

The WisdomTree U.S. MidCap Dividend Fund seeks to track the investment results of dividend-paying mid-cap companies in the U.S. equity market.

Formerly known as WisdomTree MidCap Dividend Fund through June 29, 2017.

Index Description

The WisdomTree U.S. MidCap Dividend Index is a fundamentally weighted index that measures the performance of the mid-capitalization segment of the US dividend-paying market. Prior to June 30, 2017, the WisdomTree U.S. MidCap Dividend Index was named the WisdomTree MidCap Dividend Index.
