The calculation is intended to capture the Fund's potential to earn income return over the next year given current holdings and market conditions. Duration: A measure of a bond's sensitivity to changes in interest rates. The weighted average accounts for the various durations of the bonds purchased as well as the proportion of the total government bond portfolio that they make up.
