

The WisdomTree Asia Local Debt Fund seeks a high level of total returns consisting of both income and capital appreciation. The Fund attempts to achieve its investment objective through investment in local debt denominated in the currencies of a broad range of Asian countries.

During the quarter, the WisdomTree Asia Local Debt Fund lost 1.20% on net asset value (NAV) while its performance benchmark, the HSBC Asia Local Bond Index (ALBI) lost 0.26%. The underperformance was largely due to the Fund's allocation to Australia, as well as an underweight to South Korea relative to the index.

Weak domestic demand and negative current accounts caused broad market selloffs. This was most notable in Indonesia, Thailand, and Australia. The Indonesian rupiah was the worst performing currency for the quarter, losing 6.29%. In addition, the Australian dollar's more than 4% decline wiped out positive returns from its bonds. The Fund's underweight to Indonesia (relative to index) helped offset some of the drag attributed to its Australian exposure.

South Korea was once again a strong contributor, with both currency and bonds adding value. The Fund's investment in Indian supranational bonds detracted from relative performance as supranationals underperformed sovereign bonds.

The HSBC Asian Local Bond Index tracks the total return performance of liquid bonds denominated in the local currencies in China, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Korea, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, Taiwan, and Thailand. Spot Currency Return is the return based on currency appreciation. Local Principal Return represents returns generated from the market moves of the underlying bonds. Contributed Income Return represents the returns attributed to coupon payments from the underlying bonds. Duration is a measure of a bond's sensitivity to interest rates movements.
