WisdomTree Dynamic International Equity Fund seeks to track the performance of dividend-paying companies in the industrialized world outside of the U.S. and Canada while at the same time dynamically hedging exposure to fluctuations of the value of the applicable foreign currencies relative to the U.S. dollar.

- A rules-based process that uses a combination of momentum, value and interest rate factors to help determine the currency hedge ratio
